### 1. BACKGROUND

The IOHA Collaboration Award celebrates an occupational hygienist or group of hygienists who have chosen to collaborate with other countries or organizations, rewards persons who have achieved outstanding results, and offers models to inspire others. This award raises awareness of collaboration as an effective strategy to improve outcomes, achieve scale, increase efficiency and innovation, and maximize impact.

The IOHA Collaboration Award celebrates these partnerships by giving the recipients the global recognition and platform that they deserve. Why not make a nomination for the IOHA Collaboration Award?

### 2. HOW YOU CAN NOMINATE THE PERFECT COLLABORATION

1. One of the nominees must be a member of an IOHA member national organization.


2. The collaboration can be among IOHA members or IOHA-member(s) working with other stakeholders/parties.

3. The collaboration can relate to:

- Knowledge and practice of the profession of occupational hygiene
- Development and promotion of practical solutions in the field of occupational hygiene
- Application of occupational hygiene in reducing potential health risks where resources are limited, and the need is enormous.

#### 4. Your submission of a nominee(s) needs to include:

- 4.1 Biographical details of the parties involved
- 4.2 A 500 word or less abstract of the collaboration addressing the following topics as appropriate:
- The reason for the collaboration.
- The case study
- The solution
- The outcomes
- Measurable outcome of the project in reducing potential health risk





4.3 A three-minute video that tells the story of their collaboration efforts for which they are being nominated that may be shown at the IOHA Conference in Dublin, Ireland.

# 3. JUDGING

Each nominee will be judged by an independent jury based on the following:

- Degree of collaboration
- Complexity of collaboration/impact of results
- Potential long-term sustainability/legacy of the collaboration
- Contribution to occupational hygiene within the countries of collaboration
- Presentation and quality of the submission

Nominations to be submitted no later than 1 April 2024 at 4pm UK time. The winner will be announced by 15 April 2023.

## 4. PRIZES & RECOGNITION

The winner will receive paid registration, travel, and accommodation for one person to attend the IOHA triennial conference where the award will be presented. IOHA2024 in Dublin Ireland conference-related travel and accommodation expenses for the recipient will need to be pre-approved in accordance with IOHA expense policy and later reimbursed to the winner by IOHA.

IOHA will provide maximum recognition for the award-winning collaboration by featuring it on multiple platforms, including The IOHA Conference, social media and IOHA website.

The winners will present their project in a presentation during the conference.

The IOHA Collaboration Award recipient/s will be interviewed for the Global Exposure Manager (GEM) - IOHA Newsletter.
