

Use of AIOH logo and post nominals

We are seeing cases where post-nominals and logos are not being displayed as per AIOH policies. The information below outlines the expectations for using the post-nominals and logos and all members are encouraged to check their profiles to verify they are meeting the requirements set by the AIOH.

Key messages

- Familiarise yourself with the table below that summarises the use of post-nominals and logos
- Ensure any post-nominals and logos you display are consistent with your membership grade
- Company websites must not be displaying Certified Occupational Hygienist (COH)[®] seals or AIOH logos

- AIOH logos cannot be displayed on company websites, brochures, reports or publications without express written permission by the AIOH Council.
- COH seals cannot be displayed by companies
- Individuals within a company may display post-nominals, logos or COH seals in their email or reports consistent with their membership grade
