

Use of AIOH logo and post nominals

We are seeing cases where post-nominals and logos are not being displayed as per AIOH policies. The information below outlines the expectations for using the postnominals and logos and all members are encouraged to check their profiles to verify they are meeting the requirements set by the AIOH.

Key messages

- Familiarise yourself with the table below that summarises the use of postnominals and logos
- Ensure any post-nominals and logos you display are consistent with your membership grade
- Company websites must not be displaying Certified Occupational Hygienist (COH)® seals or AIOH logos

- COH seals cannot be displayed by companies
- Individuals within a company may display post-nominals, logos or COH seals in their email or reports consistent with their membership grade
